## Villains and Heroes of the Bible:

Rabbi Warshauer will lead us on a tour to explore treasures from the Metropolitan Museum that depict characters and episodes from the Bible, as a way of gaining insights into Holy Scripture and its significance today. We'll visit works of art in a variety of forms and from several eras and regions; and examine these works for literary, artistic, psychological, and theological commentary on the episodes they show. Discussion is encouraged, and no prior background in art or Bible is necessary!

*Rabbi Warshauer received his B.A. in History from Columbia University and his ordination from the Jewish Theological Seminary. He also studied at the University of Judaism in Los Angeles, the Schechter Institute in Jerusalem, and the Pardes Institute in Jerusalem. He holds a masters degree in International Affairs, and a Certificate of the Middle East Institute, from Columbia. Prior to entering the rabbinate, he served on the staff of the U.S. House of Representatives at the Committee on Foreign Affairs.*
